Outpatients – Evidence

- It is recognised that there is limited evidence available of whole-scale pathway redesign – Stockport is leading the way
 - Specific initiatives having a positive impact include:
 - Stockport 100 day rapid test schemes in T&O, Gastro, Cardiology & Respiratory and Diabetes
 - Stockport Consultant Connect pilot across 8 specialties achieved ~40% reduction in referrals
 - Calderdale & Huddersfield GP/specialist advice & guidance achieved 57% reduction in referrals
 - NHS Greenwich GP upskilling in Diabetes treatment achieved a 12% reduction in outpatient attendances
 - UCL discharged 50% GI patients by reviewing diagnostic test results without patients having to return to clinic
 - Tower Hamlets achieved a 80% reduction in chronic kidney disease (CKD) face-to-face appointments through specialist access of patient records in EMIS
 - Ashford CCG achieved a 40% reduction in referrals by introducing clinical triage
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
